Court officials will be on-site to support in the delivery and adjudicating of the event, with semi-final and final matches having a designated official.</p> <p>There will be 4 designated match courts, and one practice court available at certain times.</p>
<p>Entry criteria</p>	<p>The prioritisation of players in the draw will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • International ranking • National Padel ranking • Tournament committee discretion <p>The rankings used will be those current at the tournament entry closing date (05/01/2024). In the case a player does not enter with a nominated partner, Tournament officials will attempt to pair that player with another of equal standard. Players who enter as pairs may be placed into the draw ahead of players who enter without a partner.</p> <p>Eligibility</p> <p>Players must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 15 years of age as at 01/01/2024 • not currently suspended by The International Padel Federation or any Member Nation, or have any outstanding financial liability or otherwise to any of these organizations, or otherwise be ineligible under any applicable code, rule, regulation, policy or procedure; • be in good standing and of good character and not likely embarrass or bring into ridicule or disrepute FIP, Tennis Australia, the applicable tournament and/or the sport of Padel, have complied with all applicable rules, regulations, policies or procedures detailed by FIP and Tennis Australia; and • confirm that they are not prohibited or restricted from playing in the tournament as a result of any visa conditions imposed on them by an Immigration Department, or other conditions imposed by the police, any other government authority or court of law.
<p>Format of Play</p>	<p>Qualifying: Elimination, Draw size: 32 (30 DA, 2 WC)</p> <p>Scoring Format: Best of 3 tiebreak sets, golden point</p> <p>Main draw: Elimination, Draw size 32 (26 DA, 4 QUAL, 2 WC)</p> <p>Scoring Format: Best of 3 tiebreak sets, golden point</p> <p>Consolation event: Elimination (players exiting in round 1 of the qualifying event or</p>



	<p>round 1 of the main draw will be eligible to sign-in for the consolation event)</p> <p>Scoring Format: Best of 2 tie-break sets (golden point) with deciding set a 10-point tie-break</p> <p>For the duration of the event, an order of play grid will be utilised. Matches will be assigned to a match court and will either follow the match before or have a 'not before time' listed. Please note depending upon length of matches, later scheduled matches may move courts.</p>
Seedings	<p>The seedings of pairs in the draw will be via:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual FIP Ranking • National Padel Ranking • Tournament committee discretion <p>The rankings used will be those current at the tournament entry closing date (19/12/2023). Any discretionary decisions on seeding will be final and binding on all parties (including all relevant players) and no one will have the right to appeal against or otherwise challenge such decisions.</p>

Daily communications	Participating players will be sent an email each night during the event with updated draws, schedule, important reminders and warm up times / courts. Please ensure updated emails are provided during the entry and payment process.
Practice Courts	<p>Practice Courts will be available from 1 hour before play starts each day. Players will be asked to vacate match courts 10 mins before play commences.</p> <p>There will be 1 court available for practice during the day. Contact tournaments@game4padel.com.au to book. Please include your name and your practice partner name and time requested.</p> <p>Please note there will be a maximum time of 30 minutes for practice bookings. Depending upon requests you may need to share the practice court.</p>
Food and Drinks	<p>Players should bring all food and water required for matches.</p> <p>Food trucks providing limited options will be available on-site on select dates and select times (TBC).</p>
Ball type	<p>New balls will be provided for each Qualifying and Main Draw match.</p> <p>Used balls will be used for Consolation.</p>
Prize money	Prize money will be paid in AUD and is awarded from 1/8 Finals onwards.



	There will be an online form for players to complete before the end of the event for prizemoney to be paid. More details regarding this form will be communicated in the lead up to the event.
Pre- and post-match	Upon arrival for scheduled matches, please ensure you check-in at the tournament desk 15 minutes before your scheduled match time. Once you have completed your match, please return to the tournament desk to report the score, and return the match balls.
Change-rooms	Basic player change room facilities will be available at Game4Padel Docklands.
Covid information	Make sure to check the Australian and Victorian government websites regularly for covid information.
Physiotherapy	There will be no physiotherapist on-site. A referral clinic will be provided prior to the event should players requiring physiotherapy treatment.
Playing attire	Players of the same team are recommended, but not obliged, to wear the same colours and refrain from wearing logos from other tours or nominated conflicting brands to the Tournament host. In the event that both teams on the same match choose to wear the same colour, the higher-ranking team will have the preference and the lower ranking team shall change to another colour.
Promotional appearances	The event has the right to approach the players for tournament events / functions, necessary for the promotion of the game, the tour and the event. As such, players must make themselves available for these activities which shall be reasonable in number and shall respect the player's tournament commitments and responsibilities.
Hotel and transport	All players will need to coordinate and pay for their own hotel and transport arrangements.
